

### Business Aim

The main objective of the programme is to ensure that staff members is to establish the availability of 100 'fastest moving' dispensary lines and thus confirming a core product stocking list.

### Key Steps

- GfK's client team conducted open audits across the Boots estate.
- The team identified product gaps; the audit process was adapted to incorporate the use of different brand names on several products

### Key Outcome & Client Quote

- The results of the audits were collated and then broken down by product, store and region.
- This allowed for the identification of trends. During the programme we were also able to identify the products with the poorest availability.
- With an overall high availability score, GfK affirmed that the products audited were among the "fastest moving" dispensary lines.
